

Circle K International Scholarship Program 2006

Students apply for the International Scholarships through the district scholarship application process. Districts then send to Circle K International one finalist for each Circle K International Scholarship that we offer. A committee will determine the recipients of the International Scholarships.

All scholarships are provided as cash awards in the form of a check issued to the college or university and the student. This check is sent directly to the college or university for deposit into the student's account and most likely will require the student to endorse the check also. Checks are disbursed in August.

Recipients are announced at the 2006 Circle K International Convention and then are posted on the Circle K International Website. All questions regarding this program should be directed to Circle K International Youth Funds Specialist, 800/549-2647, ext. 244.

Circle K International Scholarships Available Are:

- **Paul L. Frantz Circle K Past International Presidents' Scholarship:** one US\$1,000 scholarship. This scholarship was begun by these leaders to show continued support for Circle K. These past presidents believe that continued emphasis on the strength of the club level would be in the best interest of Circle K. In 2005, the scholarship was named in memory of Past President Paul L. Frantz, the 1978-1979 International President, who passed away in 2005 at the young age of 49, after fighting a courageous battle with multiple myeloma cancer. The scholarship is intended to assist and reward club presidents who have demonstrated excellence and dedication to Circle K.
- **Himmel Scholarship:** one US\$500.00 scholarship. Funded by family and friends of Harry S. Himmel, deceased President Emeritus of the Kiwanis International Foundation.
- **J. Walker Field Scholarship:** one US\$1,000 scholarship. Presented since 1985, the scholarship is in memory of J. Walker Field, a past Kiwanis governor and avid Circle K supporter from the Florida District. Although wheelchair-bound, traveling around the divisions, district, and international organization was no obstacle for J. Walker to support his beloved Circle K'ers!
- **National Dean's List Scholarship:** two US\$500 scholarships provided to Circle K members who have received the National Dean's List recognition. The scholarships are funded by National Dean's List.
- **AmerLink Scholarship:** one US\$500 scholarship. Funded by AmerLink Ltd., America's Log Home Company. AmerLink Ltd., www.amerlink.com, recognizes the important role of re-forestation. That's why we're making a scholarship available to Forestry or Environmental Science majors. Through this scholarship, we hope to help Circle K members make a career of cultivating our forest for generations to come. One US\$500 scholarship is awarded to a Circle K member in his/her Junior or Senior year pursuing a degree in Forestry or Environmental Sciences. Applicants for this scholarship need to attach an exhibit listing your major, minor or area of emphasis, anticipated graduation date, and a 500-word essay on what you hope to accomplish in your career in forestry or environmental science.
- **TruGreen Scholarship:** one US\$500 scholarship funded by TruGreen. It will go to an outstanding Circle K member who has been involved in campus or community beautification projects. Students applying for this scholarship must write a 200-word essay describing a beautification project they participated in. This essay must be signed by the Kiwanis or Faculty Advisor.
- **Cunat International Scholarship:** one US\$2,500 scholarship provided by Kiwanis International Past President Brian and Miki Cunat. Based upon leadership in his or her line of study, regardless of grade point average or financial need. **This application is included at the back of this packet and must be submitted separately to the address provided.**

To apply for these scholarships this year, you must submit either your District Scholarship Application or the CKI Scholarship Application through your district! THIS IS A CHANGE FROM PREVIOUS YEARS!!

Scholarships Available to Circle K Members by Other Organizations:

Converse College: will offer up to five scholarships (between Circle K and Key Club) to young women from each of the five Kiwanis geographic regions), for a total of up to 25 scholarships per year. Students must meet the minimum requirement for merit-based scholarship assistance (TOEFL score of 550 [paper] or 214 [computer-based] or 1000 SAT or 21 ACT and 3.0 high school or transfer college grade point average). Student meeting these requirements and referred through the partnership with Kiwanis International will be offered a scholarship equal to 50% of Converse College tuition and fees (room and board not included). Based on 2004-05 tuition and fees, the scholarship is valued at \$9,500 per year for four years, or a total of \$38,000 over four years. Kiwanis International Foundation/Circle K District Matching Scholarships Offered to Participating Districts

Application Deadline Determined by Each District

The Kiwanis International Foundation and Circle K International have designed a scholarship program to recognize Circle K members who have excelled in leadership and have provided service to others. Financial need is not a factor in this award. Each winner will receive a one-time US\$1,000 award (unless a district changes the award amount). Districts are eligible to receive up to five matching scholarships based on the amount of clubs participating in the Annual Club Gift Campaign of the Kiwanis International Foundation.

Interested students need to contact their district administrator (listed below) to determine the district's participation in the 2006 program. **Applications for this scholarship are mailed directly to the district administrator, unless he or she instructs otherwise. Each district determines its own deadline.**

Circle K International Board members and current Circle K district governors are NOT ELIGIBLE for the District Matching Scholarship program. Each district's Circle K board is to determine the procedure to select the district scholarship winner(s). The district administrator is to forward the winning recipient form and matching funds to the Kiwanis International Foundation by **May 26, 2006**.

The Kiwanis International Foundation/Circle K District Matching Scholarship recipients will be notified by the Kiwanis International Foundation, announced at the 2006 Circle K International Convention, and will be posted to the Circle K International Website. All scholarships are provided as cash awards in the form of a check issued to the college or university and the student. This check is sent directly to the college or university for deposit into the student's account and most likely requires the student to endorse the check. Checks are disbursed in August.

Who is Qualified for the Kiwanis International Foundation/District Matching Scholarship Program (these are the same qualifications for the Circle K International Scholarships)?

A Circle K Member who:

- has been an active Circle K member in good standing and is a member of a club in good standing with the district and International organizations.
- has paid dues and appears on the roster on file at Circle K International.
- is at least a part-time college student at the time of application and will be the term after the 2006 Circle K Convention.
- has a grade-point average of at least a "B" average or the equivalent of a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- has attached an official college transcript with an explanation of the grading system utilized.
- submits the application to the Circle K district administrator by the deadline established by the district. For further information, contact the administrator.
